

Welcome to the show!

Parking Lot

We will park in an outdoor parking lot at Bryant Alternative High School. We can walk from the lot to the front of the school and enter the glass doors.



Entrance

I will enter the building and be in a lobby. The show will be in the auditorium.

It will be loud in the lobby.



Will Call Table

I will go to the Will Call table to get my tickets. I will tell the person at the table my last name. They will hand me an envelope with our reserved tickets inside. The tickets will tell us where we can sit.



Ticket Table

If my family needs more tickets I can buy them at the Ticket Table.

If I forgot my earplugs or would like a fidget, I can ask the people at the Ticket Table for help.



My Ticket

The letter and number on the ticket tells me where I will be sitting for the show.



Theater Doors

The theater doors will open about 15 minutes before the show starts. This is when I can enter the theater.



Lobby

I can look around the lobby before I go into the theater.

I will see a table with snacks to buy and and a table with flowers and other things to buy.

I will see a Cast Board outside the theater doors that shows me who is in the play.



Usher

When I am ready to enter the theater I will show the ticket to an usher.

The usher will give me a program and tell me where to sit. I can ask the usher questions about the show or the theater.



The Theater

When I walk into the theater I will see many seats and a stage with a closed curtain.

I will walk down a sloping aisle to find my seat. There are seat labels on the aisles. There are 600 seats.





Sitting

There will be many other people in the seats to watch the show. I will sit next to my family but on one side of me I might sit next to someone that I do not know.



Sitting

When I sit down a person might need to walk in front of me to find their seat.



Cow Bell

Just before the show starts, someone will ring a loud cowbell in the lobby.

If I don't want to hear the loud sound, I can go to my seat when the doors open.



Start of the Show

When the back doors close and the lights go dim, then an announcer will give information over the speakers.


I will know when the show starts when the curtains open.

At the end of the show, the actors will come to the lobby in their costumes. I can talk to them and get their autographs. I do not have to stay or talk to them.
